ENGAGE ALL
District Synod Day at Lune Valley Hub, North Lancashire Circuit

Over 100 people gathered from right across the District for our ENGAGE Synod event in the Lune Valley, Lancaster on Saturday 22nd April.

Worship was ably led by members of the North Lancashire Circuit, and we were hosted excellently by the team there.

The business of Synod was dealt with in an early session of the day, including our voting in favour of the proposed amalgamation of the Lancashire District with neighbours in Cumbria, Liverpool and Bolton & Rochdale Districts, from September 2024, to become a new NW regional District, with new ways of resourcing ourselves for mission. We now look to Methodist Conference at the end of June for final discussions and decisions regarding this proposal.

The rest of the day was spent in various workshops and activities, including our Godly Play Bus and team, a trip to Cornerstone in Lancaster city centre, creative activity, prayer walking, sessions on EDI (equality, diversity, inclusion), and engagement with some of our young people present.

Video input from the day is available to view on our District YouTube channel or accessed via our District website. These include an interview with Cat Smith MP (for Lancaster and Fleetwood), member at Lancaster Methodist Church, regarding our engagement with politics, national and local, and a couple of interviews, especially recorded for our ENGAGE event, with our national Youth President, James Carver – one on ENGAGING with our children and young people, and one on ENGAGING with those who live with neuro-diversity.
